Wire cutting scissors

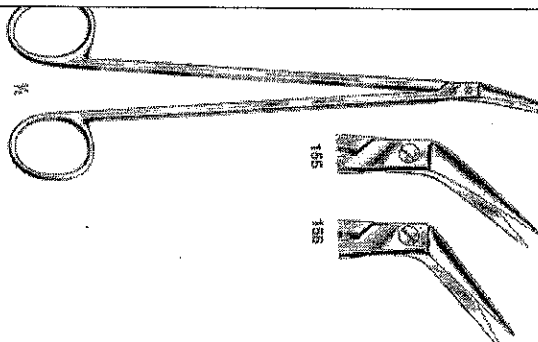
