At the end of the 19th century, the first attempts were made to use the term "psychology" in a broad sense, encompassing all the sciences that study the mind and behavior. This was the case of the German psychologist Wilhelm Wundt, who is considered the founder of psychology as a scientific discipline. Wundt's approach was based on the idea of introspection, which involves observing and reporting one's own mental experiences.





Rough Riders

- a) Theodore Roosevelt resigns as secretary of navy to join fighting
- b) Made up of college athletes, cowboys, ranchers, and Native Americans



Battle of San Juan Hill

- a) Rough Riders join and capture San Juan Hill
- b) Spanish attempt to break out of Santiago Harbor
- c) Spanish fleet destroyed



“A Splendid Little War”

- a) Lasted fewer than 4 months
- b) 400 Americans died in battle or from wounds
- c) However, more than 2,000 died of diseases
