Latin

(*ferv*, to boil + *-ent*, inclined to, in a state of)
 Having or showing great emotion or zeal.
 (*ferv*, to boil + *-id*, characterized by)
 Marked by great passion.
 (*ferv*, to boil + *-or*, someone who or something that)
 Great warmth and intensity of emotion.

14. gust

- a. gustation
- b. gustatory
- c. disgust

to taste

Latin

(*gust*, taste + *-ation*, state, quality or act)
 The act or ability of tasting.
 (*gust*, taste + *-ory*, relating to, condition of)
 Relating to the sense of taste.
 (*dis-*, opposite of, reverse + *gust*, taste)
 Causing nausea or loathing in; sicken.

15. jur, jus

- a. juror
- b. justice
- c. justify

to swear

Latin

(*jur*, to swear + *-or*, someone who)
 One who serves as a member of a jury.
 (*jus*, to swear + *-ice*, state or quality of)
 The quality of being fair.
 (*jus*, to swear + *-ify*, state or quality of)
 To prove to be right or valid.

16. -lect, lig

- a. elect
- b. eligible
- c. select

to choose

Latin

(*e-*, out of or from + *-lect*, choose)
 To select by vote for an office or for membership; to pick out.
 (*e-*, out of or from + *lig*, choose + *-ible*, able to be or do)
 Qualified to be chosen.
 (*se-*, apart + *-lect*, choose)
 To take as a choice from among several.

17. lev(i)

- a. levitate
- b. levity
- c. elevate

to lighten, lift, raise

Latin

(*levi*, to lift or raise + *-ate*, cause, to be, state, condition)
 To rise or cause to rise into the air and float.
 (*lev*, to lighten + *-ity*, state or quality of)
 Lightness of manner of speech.
 (*e-*, out of or from + *lev*, to lift or raise + *-ate*, cause, to be, state, condition)
 To move something to a higher place or position.

18. crit

- a. criterion
- b. critic
- c. criticize

to distinguish, separate, judge

Greek

(*crit*, to judge + *-er*, someone who or something that + *-ion*, state, quality or act)
 A standard, rule, or test on which a judgment or decision can be based.
 (*crit*, to distinguish or separate + *-ic*, like or related to)
 One who forms and expresses judgments of an item or matter.
 (*crit*, to judge + *-ic*, like or related to + *-ize*, cause to be, become or resemble)
 To judge the merits and faults of someone or something.
