

Adapt: to adjust something	We adapt ourselves to changing times.
Adopt: to take into one's family to take on and follow	The children were adopted by new parents. She adopted a new work schedule
Can: able to	I can speak Spanish.
May: allowed to	May we please speak in Spanish?
Discover: to find knowledge for the first time	He discovered a new galaxy.
Invent: to create for the first time	He invented a new machine.
Imply: to hint or to suggest	Mary implied the answer with a hint.
Infer: to draw a conclusion based on reason/evidence	We inferred the answer from her expression.
Aggravate: to make worse	My cold was aggravated by bad weather.
Irritate: to annoy	The bad weather irritated me making me angry.
Adhere: to stick together fast, as with glue	With Velcro fabric adheres
Cohere: to hold together as one mass	If our group does not cohere, it will fall apart.
