- a. with a semicolon
- b. with a comma and a coordinating conjunction
FANBOYS (for, and nor, but, or, yet, so)
- c. With a semicolon, a transition (however, therefore, consequently, moreover, in addition) and then a common

I like school; I get good grades.

I like school, and I get good grades.

I like school; consequently, I get good grades.
