
## **Quia Classroom Page Instructions**

**Welcome:** Students of SWCS math classes.

The following instructions will help you to navigate through the Quia websites to which you have been assigned for the current school year. You will be responsible for keeping informed on how to use the site. It has many different pages that will assist you in understanding math concepts, practicing those concepts, testing and quizzing on the concepts, and homework / classwork assigned to those pages.



<u>Miss Laughlin Profile Page</u>. You can find this page by going to quia.com and searching for a teacher using Mr. Fell for my name. From my profile page you may pick you appropriate Saxon Math Page and you will be taken to the main page for your Saxon level. From this page you can navigate to all other Saxon pages you will be using.

The <u>Class Main Page</u> will contain information on assignment due, notes from the teacher, lesson plans, documentation on how to navigate through the quia web, and how to see your scores on recorded assignments.

The <u>Practice Set Page</u> will contain the practice sets found in each lesson presented in Saxon Math. These are your homework assignments to be completed after you have learned the lesson either from the teacher in class or from online video presentations. These grades are not placed in your Renweb gradebook, but are counted in the Jr. High 10 City program as missed assignments.

The <u>Assignment Page</u> will contain written assignments found in the Saxon textbook These assignments are 10% of your grade and are placed in your Renweb gradebook. This class work must also be completed and are recorded in the Jr. High 10 City program.

The **Quiz Page** contains all quizzes related to Saxon Math and count as 30% of your grade. Results are placed into the Renweb gradebook. All quizzes with the exception of multiplication and division, must be taken during school hours.

The <u>Test Page</u> is where you will find Saxon tests as they are assigned. These results are placed into Renweb gradebook and count as 50% of your grade. Tests can only be taken during math class period.

The <u>Activities Page</u> will contain other activities that may be assigned during different times of the year for your use.

The <u>Student Zone</u> is a link that the student or parent can open and view all completed work. This page will give assignments completed, grade of assignments, and what problems were missed. To open this link requires the student's username and password.

You will be given your **Username743 and Password** at the beginning of the year.
