

Guidelines for Group Work

Decide on your project name - choose from the following:

Games for Learning

Cyberbullying

Peer Tutoring/Teaching

Journaling/Blogging/Vlogging

Social Media and Privacy

Students and Stress

Look at the notes for your project showing questions/suggestions. You can change these or extend them

If you take any information from a website:

- 1) Make sure you keep a log of the website name
- 2) Do not simply copy and paste
- 3) Summarize the information

You can divide the tasks for your project between you. You don't have to work on every piece of the project.

You need to write your name on the work that you have completed (on the slides) to show which parts you are responsible for.

You need to have a shared folder or something, where the work you have done can be seen by other members of your group, so that if anyone is absent, the project can still continue
