

## Designing Your Dream Room

## **Directions Below**

In planning your room design you should have cut out or printed out furniture items and accessories you imagine your dream room will have. It is now time to use these items!

First... Walls and floor must be covered. You may use paint, wallpaper scraps, construction paper, carpet scraps, tiles, or whatever resources you can collect to design these areas as you imagine them.

Second.... Ensure your items have been neatly cut out. You will need a sturdy material such as cardboard to adhere your furniture/accessory pieces to. Use glue stick to adhere. Cut out the items, but leave a TAB if you need to item to stand freely in your shoe box. The tab will bend and be glued down onto the box to serve as sort of a stand. For items such as a bed or table you may make 3d rectangular pieces for your box and adhere the proper covering. Design as you see fit. You may include additional items to complete your vision. When your room design is complete and you are satisfied......

Third......Type 1 paragraph for each of the following.

- 1. Tell about this room. What kind of room is it? What will you do in this room? Why is this your favorite room? ---- create a roof for your box house/room and glue this paragraph to the roof.
- 2. Tell about how much this room will cost you to design based on your spreadsheet totals. Is it worth the cost? Would you do anything different to save money in the design process if you were to truly design this room? Cut out paragraph and attach to one side of your box.
- 3. Print and cut out one of your business cards and adhere to other side of your box.
- 4. On the back of your box create a title for your room (I.e. Lisa's Purplicious Bedroom). Also include your full name and class period. Glue

on random words that you feel describe your room (fun, bright, modern, floral, cool, etc.)
