Blood Specimen Handling & Processing Review

Plasma Ammonia (Green-Top Tube)

- Error: Not kept on ice.
- Effect: False *increase* in ammonia from continued metabolic activity.
- **Prevention:** Place on *ice immediately* and analyze promptly.

Serum Potassium Frozen

- Error: Specimen exposed to freezing temperatures.
- Effect: False *high potassium* from cell rupture (hemolysis).
- **Prevention:** Keep at *controlled, non-freezing* temps.

Bilirubin Light Exposure

- Error: Sample left in bright light.
- Effect: Decreased bilirubin due to light sensitivity.
- **Prevention:** Protect with *foil* or *amber tube*.

Underfilled Light-Blue Tube (Coagulation Test)

- Error: Incorrect blood-to-additive ratio.
- Effect: Prolonged clotting time or invalid results.
- **Prevention:** *Discard and recollect* properly filled tube.

Overfilled Blood Culture Bottle

- Error: Too much blood added.
- Effect: Dilution or inhibited bacterial growth.
- **Prevention:** Follow 8–10 mL per bottle volume limit.

Vigorously Shaken Lavender Tube

- Error: Excessive shaking after draw.
- Effect: Hemolysis from mechanical trauma.
- **Prevention:** *Gently invert 5–10 times* only.

Lactic Acid Sample Not Chilled

- Error: Room temp delay for 40 minutes.
- Effect: False high lactic acid from glycolysis.
- **Prevention:** Keep *on ice*; analyze *immediately*.

Uncapped Serum Tube

- Error: Tube left open post-centrifuge.
- **Effect:** Evaporation and CO₂ loss affect pH, electrolytes.
- **Prevention:** Keep tubes *capped until testing*.

Mislabeling Specimen After Leaving Room

- Error: Possible specimen mix-up.
- Effect: Patient ID error unsafe to relabel.
- **Prevention:** *Label at bedside*; if unsure, *recollect*.

Lipid Panel After Breakfast

- Error: Collected post-meal.
- **Effect:** False high cholesterol/triglycerides.
- **Prevention:** Fast 8–12 hours before test.

Wrong Order of Draw (EDTA Before Serum)

- Error: EDTA drawn before red-top.
- Effect: Low calcium, high potassium from contamination.
- **Prevention:** Follow *proper order of draw*.

CBC Sample Frozen

- Error: Stored in freezer overnight.
- Effect: Hemolysis and destroyed cells.
- **Prevention:** Store at room temperature; process within 24 hours.

Delayed Glucose Processing (Gray-Top Tube)

- Error: Left at room temp for 6 hours.
- Effect: False low glucose from ongoing metabolism.
- **Prevention:** *Refrigerate* if testing delayed.

Plasma Not Separated from Cells

- Error: Delay after centrifugation.
- Effect: Altered analytes—K+, glucose, enzymes affected.
- **Prevention:** Separate plasma immediately.

Tubes Transported Horizontally

- Error: Placed sideways in pneumatic system.
- Effect: Leaks, clots from pressure and vibration.
- **Prevention:** Transport upright and cushioned
